### HERE ARE YOUR 'HOW TO' STEPS:

Look for objects around the house that you and your child can use for learning. Younger children especially learn better with objects that they can move around.

Cards and dice are great for practising maths.

Think of songs, rhymes and actions you can use to help your child remember better.



4

Be positive about mistakes. When your child gets something wrong, show them how to find the mistake and fix it. Then do it again, and only move on when they are ready to do so.
